Included below are the FAFSA notes regarding questions 54 and 55

The definition of legal guardianship does not include your parents, even if they were appointed by a court to be your guardians. You are also not considered a legal guardian of yourself.

Answer "Yes" If you can provide a copy of a court's decision that as of today you are an emancipated minor or are in legal guardianship. Also answer "Yes" if you can provide a copy of a court's decision that you were an emancipated minor or were in legal guardianship immediately before you reached the age of being and adult in your state. The court must be located in your state of legal residence at the time the court's decision was issued.

Answer "No" If you are still a minor and the court decision is no longer in effect at the time you became an adult.

• Emancipated Minor	Provide a copy of a court's decision documenting you are an emancipated minor from the state of your legal residence.
• Legal Guardianship	Provide a copy of a court's decision documenting you are in legal guardianship from the state of your legal residence.
