You must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents and submit the form and other required documents to Office of Financial Aid. The financial aid administrator may ask for additional information. If you have questions about verification contact Office of Financial Aid as soon as possible so that your financial aid will not be delayed. You will be required to submit all documents no later than the end of the academic year or your last date of attendance at Fisk.
