## Brief Corporate History

JULIUS ROSENWALD FUND, a national foundation with headquarters at 1901 Ellis Avenue, Chicago. No branch in Connecticut or elsewhere.

The Julius Rosenwald Fund was chartered in 1917 "for the well-being of mankind" with an endowment of \$20,000,000. The Fund has concentrated on equalization of opportunities among the various groups in America, contributing substantial sums to Negro education, Negro health, fellowships for Negroes and white Southerners, and general activities with a view to improving democratic human relations. The Fund has issued a number of books and pamphlets in the general field of race relations and democracy, certain of the publications being direct activities of the Fund and others issued through regular publishing agencies.

An unusual feature of this foundation was the stipulation by its founder that it should spend principal as well as income and conclude its work within a generation. Following these instructions, the Fund has already\* expended approximately \$22,000,000,000 (principal and income) and will conclude its activities on June 30, 1947.
